A useful model, however, for the resolution of the commercial disputes between both states and private parties that necessarily arise from such crises is provided by the Iran-United States Claims Tribunal (the Tribunal), established in 1981 pursuant to the Algiers Accords (the Accords) that freed the U.S. diplomatic personnel held hostage in Iran from 1979 to 1981.

### **Enforceability of Iran-U.S. Claims Tribunal Awards**

In Case A18, the Full Tribunal held, subject to an important caveat, that the Tribunal has jurisdiction over claims brought against Iran by Iranian-United States dual nationals only when the "dominant and effective nationality of the claimant during the relevant period from the date the claim arose until 19 January 1981 was that of the United States."

In SEDCO, Inc. and National Iranian Oil Company, Award No. ITL 55-129-3 (28 October 1985), reprinted in 9 Iran-U.S. C.T.R. 248, the Tribunal found that SEDCO is a U.S. national pursuant to Article VII, paragraph 1, of the Claims Settlement Declaration, and that SISA is SEDCO's wholly owned subsidiary.

The Iran-United States Claims Tribunal, which has been called the most significant arbitral body in history, celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2006. As of mid-2005, the Tribunal had issued over 800 awards and decisions--a total of 600 awards (including partial awards and awards on agreed terms), 83 interlocutory and interim awards, and 133 decisions--in resolving almost 3000 cases.

The Tribunal, concerned principally with the claims of US nationals against Iran, is the most important international claims tribunal to have sat in over half a century. Its jurisprudence is bound to make a uniquely important contribution to international law and, in particular, the law relating to aliens.
